Every year, more Pennsylvanians are living longer and outliving their savings. For the elderly, medications, grocery shopping, home care, and daily living have become huge burdens.

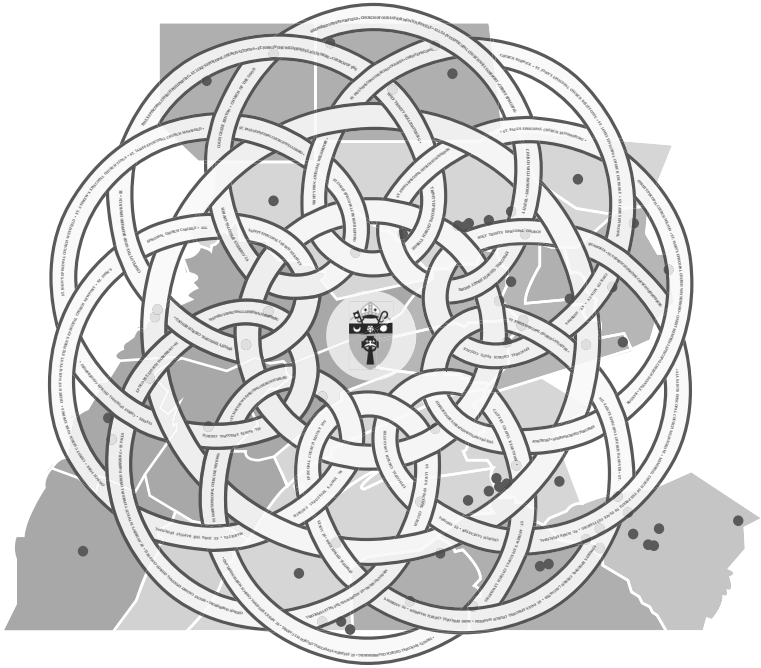
