

Sheep Construction

1. Each sheep will need a piece of cotton and chenille stems (one stem cut in fourths makes four sets of legs - enough for two sheep).
2. Twist one stem length around the cotton to form the neck.
3. Bend both ends of the stem about a quarter of an inch -- to form the feet.
4. Twist another stem length around the cotton to create the back legs.
5. Bend both ends of the stem to form the back feet. Children's imagination will transform these little lumps into sheep.
