Sheep Construction

- 1. Each sheep will need a piece of cotton and chenille stems (one stem cut in fourths makes four sets of legs enough for two sheep).
- 2. Twist one stem length around the cotton to form the neck.
- 3. Bend both ends of the stem about a quarter of an inch -- to form the feet.
- 4. Twist another stem length around the cotton to create the back legs.
- 5. Bend both ends of the stem to form the back feet. Children's imagination will transform these little lumps into sheep.
